X-RAY PELVIS & LEFT HIP

There are OA changes at both hips, with subchondral cyst formation in relation to the outer aspect of the right acetabulum. Both superior femoral head and neck junctions are prominent, which may have predisposed to osteoarthritic change due to impingement.

There is sclerosis in relation to the left side of the pubic symphysis. This would be consistent with stress reaction or inflammatory change, most likely related to the insertions of the adductor tendons. Clinical correlation is recommended. Depending on the clinical circumstances, MRI scanning could be performed to further define adductor tendinopathy.

The SI joints appear normal.
