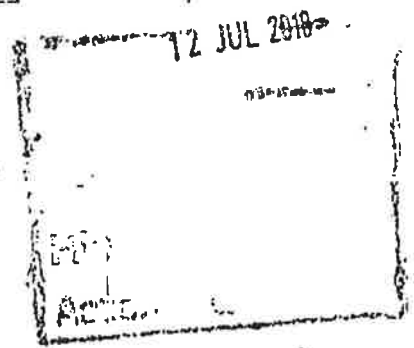

MACROSCOPIC EXAMINATION

1. "L) forehead - upper ": A punch of skin, 3 x 2 mm. 1PIBSAE.
2. "L) forehead - lower ": A punch of skin, 3 x 2 mm. 1PIBSAE. (VA)

MICROSCOPIC EXAMINATION

1. Sections of skin to deep dermis. There is mild hyperkeratosis, acanthosis with basal pigmentation and horn cysts. No melanocytic proliferation seen on H&E and Sox 10. Multiple levels reviewed. No evidence of malignancy seen. The lesion is present at lateral margins.
